Conlin also hosted the popular 2012 CBC summer radio series *Fear Itself*. *The Memento* is her first novel in fourteen years. Conlin teaches at the University of Toronto School of Continuing Studies online Creative Writing program. She lives in Wolfville, Nova Scotia.
